What is the Eden Mills Millpond Conservation Association?

The Eden Mills Millpond Conservation Association Inc. is a registered charitable corporation and de facto land trust established in 1990 for the purpose of managing the historic millpond property as a public conservation area and promoting environmental understanding and appreciation in general.

Eden Mills Millpond Conservation Association Inc. manages river valley and wetlands in the Eramosa River valley, under a land stewardship agreement with landowners - the generous and visionary Charles and Anna Simon. The agreement provides public access to this spectacular natural area, but also obliges the community to take responsibility for the stewardship of the land.

Without the Association, the expansive pond would be a trickle. Members manage the dams to keep the water high and safe; they dredge the bottom and strengthen the shorelines; they maintain the beach; they pay the costs of liability insurance to open the millpond for public use - skating, canoeing, swimming, etc.; and they provide the Going Carbon Neutral Project with non-profit and charitable status.

Members, ie Eden Mills residents, age 16+, are eligible to vote at the AGM.
